2 Enoch

Chapter 47, XLVII

1 And now, my children, lay thought on your hearts, mark well the words of your father, which are all (come) to you from the Lord's lips.

2 Take these books of your father's handwriting and read them.

3 For the books are many, and in them you will learn all the *Lord's* works, all that has been from the beginning of creation, and will be till the end of time.

4 And if you will observe my handwriting, you will not sin against the *Lord*; because there is no other except the *Lord*, neither in *heaven*, nor in earth, nor in the very lowest (places), nor in the (one) foundation.

5 The *Lord* has placed the foundations in the unknown, and has spread forth heavens visible (physical) and invisible (spiritual); he fixed the earth on the waters, and created countless creatures, and who has counted the water and the foundation of the unfixed, or the dust of the earth, or the sand of the sea, or the drops of the rain, or the morning dew, or the wind's breathings? Who has filled earth and sea, and the indissoluble winter?

6 I cut the stars out of fire, and decorated *heaven*, and put it in their midst.

2 Enoch

Chapter 48, XLVIII

1 That the sun go along the seven heavenly circles, which are the appointment of one hundred and eighty-two thrones, that it go down on a short day, and again one hundred and eighty-two, that it go down on a big day, and he has two thrones on which he rests, revolving hither and thither above the thrones of the months, from the seventeenth day of the month Tsivan it goes down to the month Thevan, from the seventeenth of Thevan it goes up.

2 And thus it goes close to the earth, then the earth is glad and makes grow its fruits, and when it goes away, then the earth is sad, and trees and all fruits have no florescence.

3 All this he measured, with good measurement of hours, and fixed A measure by his wisdom, of the visible (physical) and the invisible (spiritual).

4 From the invisible (spiritual) he made all things visible (physical), himself being invisible (spiritual).

5 Thus I make known to you, my children, and distribute the books to your children, into all your generations, and amongst the nations who shall have the sense to fear *God*, let them receive them, and may they come to love them more than any food or earthly sweets, and read them and apply themselves to them.

6 And those who understand not the *Lord*, who fear not *God*, who accept not, but reject, who do not receive the (books), a terrible judgment awaits these.

7 Blessed is the man who shall bear their yoke and shall drag them along, for he shall be released on the day of the great judgment.

2 Esdras 14:44-48

44 In forty days they wrote two hundred and four books.

45 And it came to pass, when the forty days were filled, that the Highest spake, saying, The first that thou hast written publish openly, that the worthy and unworthy may read it:

46 But keep the seventy last, that thou mayest deliver them only to such as be wise among the people:

47 For in them is the spring of understanding, the fountain of wisdom, and the stream of knowledge.

48 And I did so.

2 Esdras 14: 26

26 And when thou hast done, some things shalt thou publish, and some things shalt thou shew secretly to the wise: to morrow this hour shalt thou begin to write.

2 Esdras 14:34

34 Therefore if so be that ye will subdue your own understanding, and reform your hearts, ye shall be kept alive and after death ye shall obtain mercy.

2 Esdras 14:39-40

39 Then opened I my mouth, and, behold, he reached me a full cup, which was full as it were with water, but the colour of it was like fire.

Nag- Hammadi The Revelation of Adam, Conclusion (85, 19–32)

These are the revelations Adam disclosed to his son Seth, and his son taught them to his offspring. This is the hidden knowledge of Adam that he gave to Seth, and this is holy baptism for people who have eternal knowledge, through those born of the word and the incorruptible illuminators,⁵⁸ who have come from the holy seed, Yesseus Mazareus Yessedekus the living water, The Revelation of Adam

Nag- Hammadi The Revelation of Adam Origin of the Illuminators

But the generation without a king⁵² says, God chose him from all the eternal realms He made knowledge of the undefiled one of truth to come to be [in] him. He said, "The [great] illuminator has come [from] foreign air, [from a] great eternal realm." And [he] [83] illumined the generation of those people, whom he had chosen for himself, so that they might illumine the whole eternal realm.

Nag- Hammadi The Revelation of Adam Final Vindication of the Seed of Seth (83, 4-85, 3)

Then the offspring, who will receive his name in the water, and that of them all,⁵³ will oppose the power, and a dark cloud will overshadow them. The people will cry out with a loud voice and say, "Blessed are the souls of those people, because they have known God with knowledge of truth. They will live for ever and ever, because they have not been corrupted by their desires, as the angels have, and they have not accomplished the deeds of the powers. Rather, they have stood before

him in knowledge of God, like light that has come from fire and blood. "But we have done everything through the foolishness of the powers. We have boasted about the transgression of [all] our deeds. We have cried out against [the God] of [truth], because all of his work...[84] is eternal. Take pity on our spirits. For now we know our souls will surely die."

Then a voice came to them <from> Micheus, Michar, and Mnesinous, ⁵⁴ who are over holy baptism and living water, saying, "Why were you crying out against the living God with lawless voices and unlawful tongues and souls full of blood and foulness? You are filled with deeds far from truth, yet your ways are full of fun and laughter. You have defiled the water of life and have drawn it to the will of the powers, into whose hands you have been given, to serve them.⁵⁵ "Your thought is not like that of those people whom you persecute...desire.... [85] Their fruit does not wither.⁵⁶ Rather, they will be known up to the great eternal realms."

Nag- Hammadi The Revelation of Adam The Revelation Is Preserved on a Mountain (85, 3-18)

The preserved words of the God of the eternal realms were not copied in a book or put in writing. Angelic beings, whom none of the human generations know, will convey

them, and they will be placed on a high mountain, on a rock of truth.⁵⁷ They will be called words of incorruptibility and truth for those who know the eternal God, through wisdom of knowledge and teaching of the eternal angels, because the eternal God knows all things.

Psalms 50:16-18

16 But to the wicked person, God says: "What right have you to recite my laws or take my covenant on your lips?"

17 You hate my instruction and cast my words behind you.

18 When you see a thief, you join with him; you throw in your lot with adulterers.
