



Indeed, for them, the end result is the same: they, their wives and their children all perish and the whole of their nation is wiped from the face of the earth. And so blinded by ambition and driven by greed are the devils who advocate such treatment of these people that they cannot see that, when their victims come to obey under duress this foreign overlord and publicly recognize his authority over them, simply because of their fear of what will happen to them if they do not, such a recognition of suzerainty has no standing in law whatever, any such prerogative obtained by menaces from any people anywhere in the world being invalid. In practice, the only rights these perfidious crusaders have earned which can be upheld in human, divine, or natural law are the right to eternal damnation and the right to answer for the offences and the harm they have done the Spanish Crown by utterly ruining every one of these kingdoms and (as far as it is within their power) invalidating all claims the Spanish Crown may have to the territories of the New World. In the city of Cuzcatlán,79 very near where the town of San Salvador stands today and at that time the capital of a rich province running along the Pacific coast for some forty or fifty leagues and also called Cuzcatlán, the local people mounted a huge formal welcome for this butcher, with some twenty or thirty thousand of them lining the streets to offer hens and other foodstuffs. No sooner had he received these gifts than he instructed every man in his entourage to take as many of the locals as he wanted to act as his servants during his stay in the area and to minister to his needs. Most of them took at least fifty, some as many as a hun, dred, depending on how many each judged he would need to satisfy his every whim. These

poor wretches went unprotestingly, like lambs to the slaughter, to the man who selected them, doing everything their new master asked of them and treating him almost as a god. The Spanish captain, meanwhile, requested the local dignitaries to bring him large quantities of gold, this being the main object of the expedition. The locals said that they would willingly give him all the gold they had and collected together a vast number of the gilt copper hatch, ets that are in common use among them and which have the appearance of gold because they do have some gold in them. The captain ordered his men to test them by scratching the surface of the metal and, as soon as he saw that they were in fact made of copper, addressed his men, saying: 'The Devil take this place. There is no gold for us here, men. Let's be off, and let each take with him his local servants, put them in chains and brand them as slaves.' And this is what they did, tying up everyone they could catch and branding them, and I myself saw the son of one of the leading citizens of the city branded with His Majesty's mark as a com, mon slave. Once the people of the area and those from the town who had managed to escape the clutches of the Spaniards saw the evil that was being wrought upon their fellow-countrymen, they began to band together and take up arms against their tormentors.



European colonizers killed so many Native Americans that it changed the global climate, researchers say

(CNN)When Europeans arrived in the Americas, they caused so much death and disease that it changed the global climate, a new study finds.

European settlers killed 56 million indigenous people over about 100 years in South, Central and North America, causing large swaths of farmland to be abandoned and reforested, researchers at University Col, lege London, or UCL, estimate. The increase in trees and vegetation across an area the size of France re, sulted in a massive decrease in carbon dioxide (CO₂) in the atmosphere, according to the study.

Carbon levels changed enough to cool the Earth by 1610, researchers found. Columbus arrived in 1492,

"CO2 and climate had been relatively stable until this point," said UCL Geography Professor Mark Maslin, one of the study's co-authors. "So, this is the first major change we see in the Earth's greenhouse gases."

Before this study, some scientists had argued the temperature change in the 1600s, called the Little Ice Age, was caused only by natural forces.

But by combining archaeological evidence, historical data and analysis of carbon found in Antarctic ice, the UCL researchers showed how the reforestation -- directly caused by the Europeans' arrival -- was a key component of the global chill, they said.

"For once, we've been able to balance all the boxes and realize that the only way the Little Ice Age was so intense is ... because of the genocide of millions of people," Maslin told CNN.

The methodology

Researchers analyzed Antarctic ice, which traps atmospheric gas and can reveal how much carbon diox, ide was in the atmosphere centuries ago.

"The ice cores showed that there was a larger dip in CO₂ (than usual) in 1610, which was caused by the land and not the oceans," said Alexander Koch, lead author of the study.

A small shift in temperatures -- about a 10th of a degree in the 17th century -- led to colder winters, frosty summers and failing harvests, Koch said.


The implications

The implications of the study go beyond climate science and also contribute to research in geography and history, Maslin said, noting that deaths of indigenous Americans directly contributed to the success of the European economy.

Natural resources and food shipped from the New World helped Europe's population to expand. It also allowed people to stop farming for sustenance and begin working in other industries for spare money.

"The really weird thing is, the depopulation of the Americas may have inadvertently allowed the Europe, ans to dominate the world," Maslin said. "It also allowed for the Industrial Revolution and for Europeans to continue that domination."





WHO IS AN INDIAN? WHO IS A NEGRO? Virginia Indians in the World War II Draft

Who is an Indian? Who is a Negro? How does one decide a person's race? Few Americans have ever had the occasion to ponder deeply these questions. In most cases the answer is self-evident. A racial label is usually assigned by reference to obvious physical criteria, such as skin color, hair texture, and facial characteristics. But in any multiracial society there are some people who cannot be neatly placed into one of a limited number of categories. Further, in a society where one's social position depends heavily upon race, resolving questions of racial classification becomes a serious issue. People of mixed race may attempt to improve their position by changing their racial designation. Such an attempt forces government officials to confront directly the delicate issue of the determination of race. Their decisions have far-reaching consequences, not only for the people directly involved, but also for the entire society.

During the Second World War a small group of Virginia Indians challenged the prevailing system of racial classification. When called to register with the Selective Service System, they listed their race as Indian. Local draft boards, however, would not accept this claim. They recalled that in antebellum days some of the registrants' ancestors had married free Negroes. Based on this "evidence," the boards insisted that the proper classification for all alleged Indians was "Negro." The Indians were adamant in refusing this designation. Draft board members were equally determined not to classify the men as Indians because such a classification would mean that they would be sent to military service together with whites. For five years the Indians appealed this decision through the channels of the state and federal Selective Service bureau-



To Be Young, Gifted and White

I don't necessarily like the term "white privilege."

I use it because society has already accepted a universal, but flawed, defini, tion of the word. Although many understand that whiteness, in and of itself, gifts one at birth with opportunities not afforded to people of color, I under, stand why many white people push back against the phrase.

There is no such thing as white privilege.

What we refer to as "privilege" is actually the reality that whites don't have to overcome many of the obstacles faced by black people every day. Privilege is the freedom to live in any neighborhood you can afford. It is the advantage of getting a job based on your ability and education alone. It is the benefit of not looking like a menace when you wear a hoodie. It's

never being described as "suspicious" when you are simply existing. Privilege living is a coun, try, a city or a neighborhood where you are never out of place.

White privilege is simply the absence of racism.

When people of no color face an obstacle, they are insulted when whiteness doesn't work to their advantage. They consider the erasure of their birthright entitlement as an affront. Still, this is not their fault. Our society did this.

USA Today recently illustrated how this works on two consecutive days by publishing some carefully crafted white nonsense about the Covington Catholic varsity white supremacy squad, one of whose members, Nicholas Sandmann, recently filed a lawsuit against the Wash, ington Post for defamation.

Stephen Crockett of The Root writes:

According to the lawsuit, which has been viewed by the Post, 16-year-old Nicholas Sand, mann, believes that he was "targeted and bullied" by the newspaper in order to embarrass President Trump.

"In a span of three days in January of this year commencing on January 19, the Post en, gaged in a modern-day form of McCarthyism by competing with CNN and NBC, among oth, ers, to claim leadership of a mainstream and social media mob of bullies which attacked, vili, fied, and threatened Nicholas Sandmann, an innocent secondary school child," reads the com, plaint.

It added, "The Post ignored basic journalist standards because it wanted to advance its well-known and easily documented, biased agenda against President Donald J. Trump by im, pugning individuals perceived to be supporters of the President."

In Wednesday's USA Today, Larry Strauss communicated this belief by writing about why the sweet little Covington kids deserved an apology, not because they were slandered, "but because they are children," Strauss whitesplained. "And even if they did something offensive...they should not be subjected to the televised and publicized judgment of grown, ups."

Strauss' write-up was hands-off when it came to judging the offensiveness of the kids' deeds and how those actions may have impacted others. His point was that they are only kids, and are supposed to be immature.

Strauss' article followed a Tuesday opinion piece by Kirsten Powers, who wrote an open apology to the MAGA teens for burdening them with the responsibility of being accused of shit they actually did. Unlike Strauss, Powers admits that the teenagers "behaved disrespect, fully," but she says she believes that they "don't deserve to have their entire lives defined by one day."

Powers went on to offer another mea culpa to Trump supporters for calling them racist. Even though handing power and authority to a racist is unquestionably an act of racism, Pow, ers explains that "one person is not responsible for the sins of everyone," adding that: "Peo, ple should not be treated as disposable and banished in perpetuity with no path to restora, tion with society."

To be fair, Powers did note that black people don't get the same latitude, writing:

I know there is a double standard when it comes to the benefit of the doubt in our cul, ture. People of color, especially young black men, rarely receive the benefit of the doubt or context for their failings and can receive a literal death sentence as a result. I just don't be, lieve that refusing to provide white people the benefit of the doubt will right that wrong.

Oh, to be young, gifted and white.

Imagine if you will, living in a world and being protected by a system that handed you an endless supply of "Get Out of Everything Free" cards at birth. Whiteness is the Everlasting Gob, stopper of excuses. It is an eternal mulligan and eraser of reality.

What Sandmann, Strauss and Powers want is admirable. They are not advocating for spe, cial entitlements only meant for white kids. They believe all kids should be afforded these rights, even though they know that black children never benefit from this default benevo, lence.

That is not privilege. That is proof.



American Holocaust, IN THE DARKNESS of an early

July morning in 1945, on a desolate spot in the New Mexico desert named after a John Donne sonnet celebrating the Holy Trinity, the first atomic bomb was exploded. J. Robert Oppenheimer later remembered that the immense flash of light, followed by the thunderous roar, caused a few observers to laugh and others to cry. But most, he said, were silent. Oppenheimer himself recalled at that instant a line from the Bhagavad- Gita:



I am become death, the shatterer of worlds.

There is no reason to think that anyone on board the Niña, the Pinta, or the Santa María, on an equally dark early morning four and a half centuries earlier, thought of those ominous lines from the ancient Sanskrit poem when the crews of the Spanish ships spied a flicker of light on the windward side of the island they would name after the Holy Saviour. But the intui, tion, had it occurred, would have been as appropriate then as it was when that first nuclear blast rocked the New Mexico desert sands.

In both instances-at the Trinity test site in 1945 and at San Salvador in 1492-those mo, ments of achievement crowned years of intense personal struggle and adventure for their protagonists and were

culminating points of ingenious technological achievement for their countries. But both instances also were prelude to orgies of human destructiveness that, each in its own way, at, tained a scale of devastation not previously witnessed in the entire history of the world.

Just twenty-one days after the first atomic test in the desert, the Japanese industrial city of Hiroshima was leveled by nuclear blast; never before had so many people-at least 130,000, probably many more -died from a single explosion. Just twenty-one years after Columbus's first landing in the Caribbean, the vastly populous island that the explorer had renamed His, paniola was effectively desolate; nearly 8,000,000 people-those Columbus

captivity. 6 And it came to pass that I beheld this great and abomina, ble church; and I saw the devil that he was the founder of it.






7 And I also saw gold, and silver, and silks, and scarlets, and finetwined linen, and all manner of precious clothing; and I saw many harlots.

The first raid took place in 1515 when natives from Guanaja in the Bay Islands off Honduras were captured and taken to forced labor camps in depopulated Cuba. Other slave expeditions followed, and by 1525, when Cortés arrived in the region, all the Bay Islands themselves had been entirely shorn of their 55

In order to exploit most fully the land and its populace, and to satisfy the increasingly dangerous and rebellion-organizing ambitions of his well-armed inhabitants. Spanish troops, Columbus instituted a program called the repartimiento or "Indian grants"-later referred to, in a revised version, as the system of encomiendas. This was a dividing-up, not of the land, but of entire peoples and communities, and the bestowal of them upon a would-be Spanish master. The master was free to do what he wished with "his people"-have them plant, have them work in the mines, have them do anything, as Carl Sauer puts it, "without limit or bene, fit of tenure."56

The result was an even greater increase in cruelty and a magnification of the firestorm of human devastation. Caring only for short-term material wealth that could be wrenched up from the earth, the Spanish overlords on Hispaniola removed their slaves to unfamiliar lo, cales—"the roads to the mines were like anthills," Las Casas recalled—deprived them of food, and forced them to work until they dropped. At the mines and fields in which they labored, the Indians were herded together under the supervision of Spanish overseers, known as min, eros in the mines and estancieros on the plantations, who "treated the Indians with such

rigor and inhumanity that they seemed the very ministers of Hell, driving them day and night with beatings, kicks, lashes and blows and calling them no sweeter names than dogs." Need, less to say, some Indians attempted to escape from this. They were hunted down with mas, tiffs. When found, if not torn apart on the spot, they were returned and a show- trial was held for them, and for the edification of other Indians who were made to stand and watch. The es, capees were brought before the visitador [Spanish inspector- magistrate] and the accuser, that is, the supposedly pious master, who accused them of being rebellious dogs and good-for-nothings and demanded stiff punishment. The visitador then had them tied to a post and he himself, with his own hands, as the most honorable man in town, took a sailor's tarred whip as tough as iron, the kind they use in galleys, and flogged them until blood ran from their naked bodies, mere skin and bones from starvation. Then, leaving them for dead, he stopped and threatened the same punishment if they tried 57 it again." American Holocaust, David Stannard pg 73



Il Columbus's second voyage was the true beginning of the inva, sion of the Americas. The royal instructions authorizing the expedi, tion had directed that the finest ships in Andalusia be outfitted for the trip and that they be commanded by the most expert pilots and navigators in the realm. Seventeen ships made the voyage and aboard those ships were more than 1200 soldiers, sailors, and colo, nists-including a cavalry troop of lancers and half a dozen priests. Along the way, at the Canary Islands, some other passengers were boarded: goats and sheep and cattle, and eight pigs, were placed on deck and in the holds below.



In early January of 1494 the fleet arrived at the place on the north, ern coast of Hispaniola that Columbus had chosen to build his New

World capital, his town of Isabela. No sooner were the ships unloaded, however, than sickness broke out among the crews. It quickly spread among the natives, who had come to greet the ships with gifts of fish and fruits, "as if we had been their brothers," recalled one of the men on board.days, the Admiral's surgeon

Within a few reported, a third of the Spaniards had fallen ill, while natives everywhere were dead. Columbus directed groups of the healthy among his crews to explore the island's inland regions and find the fabulous gold mines they all were sure existed. But many of those men returned to the ships, having come down with the mysterious illness along the way.

For years historians have speculated as to what the epidemic was that laid low so many Spaniards and killed so many native people. Carl Sauer thought it might have been some sort of intestinal infection, while Samuel Eliot Morison diagnosed it as either malaria or some, thing caused by "drinking well water and eating strange fish." American Holocaust, David E, Stannard, pg 67

Wherever the marauding, diseased, and heavily armed Spanish forces went out on patrol, accompanied by ferocious armored dogs that had been trained to kill and disembowel, they preyed on the local communities- already plague-enfeebled- forcing them to supply food and women and slaves, and whatever else the soldiers might desire. "Siege," as Inga Clendinnen has observed, was for the Aztecs "the antithesis of war." The ensuing battle was furious and horrifying, and continued on for months. Cortés extended his martial strategy by destroying not only the Aztecs, food and water sup, plies, but their very city itself. His soldiers burned magnificent public buildings and market, places, and the aviaries with their thousands of wondrous birds; they gutted and laid waste parks and gardens and handsome boulevards. The metropolis that the Spanish had just months earlier described as the most beautiful city on earth, so dazzling and beguiling in its exotic and brilliant variety, became a monotonous pile of rubble, a place of dust and flame and death. pg 78

We now learnt from two wretched creatures who had escaped from the city and come to our camp by night that they were dying of hunger and used to come out at night to fish in the canals between the houses, and wandered through the places we had won in search of firewood, and herbs and roots to eat. . . . I resolved to enter the next morning shortly before dawn and do all the harm we could. . . . and we fell upon a huge number of people. As these were some of the most wretched people and had come in search of food, they were nearly all unarmed, and women and children in the main. We did them so much harm through all the streets in the city that we could reach, that the dead and the prisoners numbered more than eight hundred.

With the advantage finally theirs-even if it was against "wretched . . . unarmed . . . women and children in the main"-Cortés and the Spanish pressed on. "That day," wrote Cortés, "we did nothing save burn and raze to the ground the houses on either side of that main street, which indeed was a sad sight; but we were obliged to do it, there being no other way of ac, complishing our aims."

They moved their forces to another section of the city where they slaughtered and cap, tured more than twelve thousand people. Within a day or two they had another multitude of helpless citizens penned in: "They no longer had nor could find any arrows, javelins or stones with which to attack us." More than forty thousand were killed in that single day, and "so loud was the wailing of the women and children that there was not one man amongst us whose heart did not bleed at the sound." Indeed, because "we could no longer endure the stench of the dead bodies that had lain in those streets for many days, which was the most loathsome thing in all the world," recalled Cortés, "we returned to our camps." But not for long. The next morning the Spanish were in the streets again, mopping up the starving, dehydrated, and disease-wracked Indians who remained. "I intended to attack and slay them all," said Cortés, as he observed that: The people of the city had to walk upon their dead while others swam or drowned in the waters of that wide lake where they had their canoes; indeed, so great was their suffering that it was beyond our understanding how they could endure it. Countless numbers of men, women and children came out toward us, and in their eagerness to escape many were pushed into the water where they drowned amid that multitude of corpses; and it seemed that more than fifty thousand had perished from the salt water they had drunk, their hunger and the vile stench. . . . And so in those streets where they were we came across such piles of the dead that we were forced to walk upon them." American Holocaust, David E, Stannard,

As Bishop Diego de Landa (who was a brutal overlord himself) described the process in his region of the Yu, catan: "the Spaniards pacified [the Indians of Cochua

and Chetumal] in such a way, that these provinces which were formerly the thickest settled and most populous, remained the most desolate of all the country." In these besieged prov, inces, added Fray Lorenzo de Bienvenida, "the Indians fled from all this and did not sow their crops, and all died of hunger. I say all, because there were pueblos of five hundred and one thousand houses, and now one which has one hundred is large." The Spanish had a saying, recalled Alonso de Zorita, that it was easy to find one's way from province to province, be, cause the paths were marked with the bones of the dead. There are "certain birds," he added, "that, when an Indian falls, pick out his eyes and kill and eat him; it is well known that these birds appear whenever the Spaniards make an incursion or discover a mine." Indeed, to this day there exist in Yucatán towns and villages Spanish buildings and monuments that cele, brate the sixteenth- century slaughter. One example is Montejo house in Mérida-on the coast, near the sites of the ancient Maya cities of Uxmal and Chichén Itzá-whose façade is decorated with two proud and preening conquistadors, each of whom has his feet planted atop the severed heads of Indians. In western Nicaragua 99 percent of the people were dead (falling in number from more than 1,000,000 to less than 10,000) Pg. 84

As elsewhere, the conquistadors, diseases preceded them-smallpox, and probably other epidemics swept down through Mexico and across the Andes in the early 1520s, even before Pizarro's first foray into the region-but also as elsewhere the soldiers and settlers who followed wreaked terrible havoc and destruction themselves.
